It has been quiet for too long on this site. There are a few reasons for that.

One reason is that instead of redefining and promoting the interfaces, We have been working on tools just to see if the definitions are usable at all.

This resulted in 2 other opensource projects, called Testium and Simple Test Result Tool. Testium is a Test Execution Tool written in java and the Simple Test Result Tool is a Reporting Tool based on XSL and PHP. We hope to release the first versions of both tools soon.

As a side effect, the tools resulted in API's for the used interfaces that will be published soon as well.

An other reason is that we have switched to a more reliable web-hosting provider. After changing the testinginterfaces.com domain to the more appropriate testtoolinterfaces.com, we had to change the domain once more from .com to .org. I hope TestToolInterfaces.org will remain in operation for a while and that the downtimes are history.
